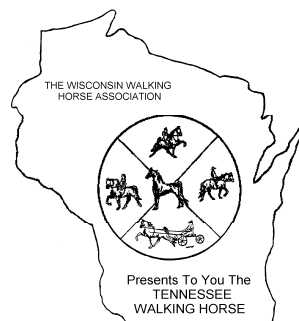

Office Fee: \$ 8.00 each horse, per day of showing

Class Fees: \$10.00 Regular classes
\$ 8.00 Versatility classes

Versatility Classes: 2, 17-23, 41, 59-63

Stall Fees: \$40.00 - horse or tack, includes both days

Camping: \$25.00 per night w/ plug in, \$15.00 w/o plug in.
Arrival permitted 6/6 after 5 p.m.

Trailer Tie Fee: \$5.00 per horse/day

Negative EIA Test from the current calendar year required for all horses.

Current Health Certificate required for out of state horses.
All classes are open to adult and youth participants unless otherwise specified.

O/T: Denotes optional tack & attire (English or Western) but not a combination thereof.

Amateur Own/Train: No professional training within 90 days.

Novice Horse or Rider: Has not won 3 blues in a mounted rail class since 01-01-05 (*Horse excludes Equitation; rider includes equitation*).

Amateur Country Pleasure Division: Registration papers and amateur cards not required.

Amateur Trail Pleasure Divisions: TWHBEA registration papers and amateur card required. Please refer to NHSC rule book. Information is also available at entry desk.

ALL Classes: Open to ALL horses showing in mounted rail classes at this show including all horses entered in the Trail Pleasure and Country Pleasure Divisions.
