Office Fee: \$10.00 each horse per day of showing

Class Fees: \$10.00 Regular and Versatility Classes
\$15.00 Championship Classes

Stall Fees: \$40.00 Includes both days, horse or tack

Camping: \$25.00 per night with plug in, \$10.00 w/o plug in. Arrival permitted 6/5/09 after 5pm.

Trailer Tie Fee: \$5.00 per horse per day

Negative EIA Test from current calendar year required for all horses. Please provide copy to entry booth.

All classes are open to adult and youth participants unless otherwise specified.

O/T: Denotes optional tack & attire (English or Western), but not a combination thereof.

Amateur Own/Train: No professional training within 90 days.

Novice Horse or Rider : Has not won 3 blues in a mounted rail class since 01-01-06 (Horse excludes equitation; rider includes equitation).

Speed Events: Safety helmets required for youth 17 & under; optional for adults.

Amateur Country Pleasure Division (Registration papers and Amateur Cards not required)

Amateur Trail Horse Division: Please refer to NHSC rule book. Information is also available at entry desk.

Qualification for Championship Classes: A horse must have completed a 2 gait rail class to enter a 2 gait Championship Class. A horse must have completed a 3 gait rail class to enter a 3 gait Championship class.
